Frank Willett Young was born 27 Aug. 1882, in Sonoma Co., Calif., the son of Nicholas Jerome Young, born 17 May 1853, near Springfield, Illinois, and his wife Alvaretta M. Inskeep, who was born 22 Jan. 1852. He married 18 Aug. 1914, in the Methodist Church in Euclid Heights, Los Angeles, Calif., Ethel Toinette Cote, who was born 23 Dec. 1889 in Ryan, Iowa, the daughter of Leon L. Cote and his wife Frances Alwilda Burnight.

Mr. and Mrs. Frank W. Young resided in El Centro, Calif., from 1914 to 1928, then removed to Montgomery Creek, Shasta Co., Calif., where they remained ten years. In 1938 they returned to their old home in El Centro, where they are now (1948) residing (583 Euclid Ave.).
